Our Chevy Chase office has the following positions available for social workers for the treatment and specialized foster care programs:

Assistant Case Manager

The Assistant Case Manager is responsible for case work and support to the foster care families. Works with the case managers and intake programs with the placement, scheduled visitations to schools, homes and other required services for the children, biological and foster families. The Assistant Case Manager completes documentation required following policies and procedures.

- *Bachelor's Degree in Social Work (BSW) or related field; **OR** High School Diploma or GED **with a minimum** of three years of experience working in child welfare, social rehabilitation or related field .*
- *Demonstrated ability to work with families from different socio-economic, ethnic and language backgrounds.*
- *Good oral and written communication skills.*

Case Manager (BSW-LASW)

The Case Manager is responsible for writing service plans and other required reports for each foster child assigned. Attends case reviews, meetings, and case conferences. The Case Manager provides case management services to foster and biological families base on the service plans.

- *Bachelors Degree in Social Work (BSW), Psychology or related field.*
- *Knowledge of case management work and foster care programs.*
- *Must have access to an automobile and valid driver's license.*

Education Liaison

The Educational Liaison monitors the quality of education and training services to, and education progress of, children in PSI foster care. The Educational Liaison works closely with the Team Coordinators, and Case Managers to identify educational needs of children and insure timely delivery of services. The Educational Liaison serves as the advocate for children, conducting workshops for staff and foster parents on how to meet the educational and training needs of the children they serve. The Educational Liaison may serve as a member of the Performance Improvement Team and attend IEP case conferences.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- *Must type a minimum of 30 words per minute and have knowledge of work processing.*
- *Excellent organizational, interpersonal, and written and oral communication skills.*
- *Bachelor's Degree in Education or related field.*
- *Knowledge of and sensitivity to the PSI foster care mission.*
- *Understanding of cultural competence in serving diverse populations and working with diverse staff.*
- *Knowledge of Special Educational Services, IEP development, and education surrogates.*

Team Coordinator

Supervises assigned case managers/mental health therapist to ensure quality of service, and adherence to the program plan and PSI and state regulations, policies and procedures.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- *Meets qualifications of Case Manager II/Mental Health Therapist II.*
- *Ability to supervise case managers and mental health therapists, reviewing service/treatment plans, directing services and responding to crises.*
- *Knowledge of the Program foster care program requirements, including PSI policies and procedures, program plans, and state rules and regulations.*
- *Knowledge of state foster care regulations and state organizations, personnel and procedures.*
- *Knowledge of community resources in the areas in which PSI has foster homes.*
- *Hold license or certification if required by PSI policy or state regulations.*

Mental Health Therapist

The Mental Health Therapist writes and follows treatment plans, manages psychotherapy services for cases after the intake process. Provides individual and family therapy following each treatment plan.

- *Master's Degree or Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology or Psychiatric Social Work.*
- *Minimum of two (2) years of direct psychotherapy work with children, adolescents and/or adults.*
- *Knowledge of foster care, cognitive therapy and clinical recordings.*
- *Excellent diagnostic and clinical writing skills.*
- *Must have access to an automobile and have a valid driver's license.*

BALTIMORE

The Baltimore office has the following positions available for the various foster care programs:

Case Manager

The Case Manager is responsible for assessing the needs of the families and individuals in the development of service plans for each child. Responsible for the assigned cases in providing services to achieve goals for the children, foster families and biological families. Maintains face-to-face contact with families to provide case management services.

- *Masters Degree in Social Work (MSW)*
- *Must be a Licensed Social Worker in the state of Maryland*
- *Knowledge of child protective services and foster care*

Mental Health Technicians (On-Call Positions)

The Mental Health Technician works directly with the youth providing daily one-on-one supervision following the treatment plans. Escorts residents monitoring them and providing support as needed.

- *High School Diploma or GED*
- *Minimum two years of experience in human services*
- *Understanding of cognitive behavioral techniques*
- *Must have access to an automobile and valid driver's license*

Speech/Language Pathologist (Consultant)

The Speech/Language Pathologist is responsible for assessing the level of speech and language competence of the children. Provides communication consultation to foster parents, biological parents, and teachers. The Speech/Language Pathologist also participates in the clinical files review.

- *Masters Degree in Speech Pathology.*
- *Licensed as a Speech Pathologist in the state of Maryland.*
- *One year or more of experience working with children and youth.*
- *Must have access to an automobile and valid driver's license.*
